COMING TO CODY, WYOMING/ FINDING PONDEROSA CAMPGROUND

Coming north on Interstate 25 from the south/southeast - Go north on Interstate 25 into Wyoming, as far as Casper, Wyoming. Take Exit 189, which is the Highway 20 Bypass, toward US 20 and US 26 and Shoshoni. Follow US Highways 20/26 to Shoshoni, then follow US 20 to Thermopolis. At Thermopolis, take Highway 120 to Cody. Good two-lane road; minimal mountain passes.

Coming west on Interstate 90 from the east – Interstate 90 joins up with Interstate 25 at Buffalo, Wyoming. You can either take Highway 16 out of Buffalo, Wyoming to Worland, Greybull and Cody, or you can take Highway 14 just north of Sheridan to Greybull and then to Cody. Highway 16 may have less steep, mountainous road, but you'll have a little bit either way. Very drivable in a coach, just go slowly!! Alternate Highway 14A from Sheridan to Lovell and then to Cody is not recommended. There was a slide earlier this year and there is still a detour, plus it is the most steep and winding of the three routes from the east.

Coming south from Interstate 90 from the north via Montana - If you come west on Interstate 94 and 90 into Montana, (or east on Interstate 90 from western Montana) you'll continue on Interstate 90 to Exit 434 (Laurel, Montana). At Laurel, go south on Highway 310. The road turns left at the Rockvale intersection, but just keep following Highway 310 toward Bridger. Just south of Bridger, we recommend you take Highway 310 toward Lovell. Road signs will point you to Cody on Highway 72 but there is a 10-mile stretch of construction that is VERY ROUGH on Highway 72 between Bridger and Belfry and it is not fun! Follow Highway 310 through Frannie to Deaver. At Deaver, take route 114 to Garland/Powell, then Alternate 14A to Powell and into Cody. This route is 5-6 miles longer than Highway 72, but much more pleasant because you'll avoid the construction.

<u>Coming east from Yellowstone National Park from the west</u> – You can't get lost! Leave the Park East Entrance, heading east and follow Highway 14/16 for 52 miles to Cody. Ponderosa Campground will be on your left.

<u>Finding Ponderosa Campground</u> - Regardless of which way you arrive into Cody (from the south, east or north), there are big signs pointing toward Yellowstone National Park. Just follow Highways 14/16/20 west toward Yellowstone National Park. **From Highway 120**, turn left onto Highway 14/16/20, which becomes 17th Street. Take 17th street down the hill, thru the curve to the left where 17th Street becomes Sheridan Avenue (the main drag); take Sheridan Avenue, then go thru the curve to the left where Sheridan Avenue becomes 8th Street. Go roughly half a mile from on 8th Steer and you'll see Ponderosa Campground on your right. **From Highway 14/16/20** via Greybull into Cody, the road becomes 17th Street. Follow directions above from 17th Street. **From Highway 14A**, the road will make a left hand curve, becoming 16th Street. Turn right from 16th street onto Sheridan Avenue (the main drag). Follow directions above from Sheridan Avenue to Ponderosa Campground.
